Interventional Workshop

This is a half day workshop to be held at Queen Elizabeth Hospital in the morning from 9:00am – 12:00pm on 23 April 2010 (Friday).

The workshop will be conducted by Dr. Murray Taverner from Australia with Dr. Theresa Li facilitating. It will focus on interventional pain management for low back pain, and will include live demonstration of procedures such as radiofrequency of sacroiliac joint and other percutaneous spinal interventional procedure for pain management, followed by lecture, discussion and sharing of experience with the guest expert. The workshop will be suitable for doctors who care for patients with low back pain.

- 3. Short presentation by Dr. Murray Taverner
- 4. Open discussion
